



- One of the fastest-growing markets in Latin America and 3rd best country for "Ease of doing business in Latin America
- Colombia is part of the CIVETS group (Colombia, Indonesia, Vietnam, Egypt, Turkey and South Africa) –
 countries that have been identified as the next generation of economic tigers
- Rapid expansion of the extractive industries, such as oil, coal, and nickel
- Strategic location as a regional hub with duty free access to the other Andean nations, Mercosur and Chile
- The dynamic "youth" sector of the population represents the driving force
- Middle class forecast to double in next 15 years
- Bogota is the second largest luxury market in South America, after Sao Paulo
- One of the most open markets in Latin America with 13 Free Trade Agreements in force
- Over 100 UK business operate in the Colombia
- Ranked 18th In the World retail Index: retailing is responsible for 40% of all sales in the country





- One of the world's most rapidly developing economies with a GDP per head that is greater than India and China
- 400 of the world's 500 largest companies operate in Brazil
- One of four countries which make up the BRIC (Brazil, Russia, India and China) economies
- Strong industrial, business and consumer base
- European-oriented culture and business practices
- Sao Paolo is the first largest luxury market in South America
- UK's largest trading partner in Latin America
- Largest energy market in South America and has the second largest oil reserves in Latin America
- The Brazilian Aerospace Industry is the largest in the Southern Hemisphere

Killer Facts

- Largest economy in Latin America, after Brazil with a GDP per capita that is larger than the rest of the BRIC (Brazil, Russia, India and China) countries
- World's 15th largest economy, according to the International Monetary Fund (IMF)
- It is the country with the most FTAs in the world: access to the US market under the NAFTA and 11 FTAs covering 44 countries with a potential market access of up to 60% of the world's GDP
- In July 2000 the EU and Mexico signed a free trade agreement known as the 'Global Agreement' which helps EU goods gain preferential access to Mexico
- 2015: year of the UK in Mexico and Mexico in the UK
- Manufacturing powerhouse responsible for more than 60% of Latin America's manufacturing exports
- Increasing middle class fosters retail sector
- A National Infrastructure Plan has been set up to develop more modernised highways, rails, ports and airports
- Did you know that importing a standard container of goods into Mexico requires 4 docs, 12 days, £1176?


